2024 Level 6 Snow Day Friday 19 July

Dear Parents and Carers,

On Friday 19 of July, the Level 6 students will have the opportunity to attend a day of skiing at Mt Buller.

The day will begin with **departure from JPPS at approximately 5:30am (to be confirmed) and students returning to school at approximately 8:30pm** in the evening. Students will arrive on the mountain, be fitted for skis, boots, helmets and poles before beginning a 1.5 hour ski lesson. After the lesson, students will have a few hours of supervised skiing/playing in the snow, before returning home via the Mansfield Pub for a pre-organised dinner. Please see the proposed itinerary for a more detailed account of the day on page 2 of this notice.

The cost of the excursion will be \$276 and will include transport, lift tickets, ski lessons, equipment hire (including skis, boots, helmet and poles) as well as dinner at the Mansfield Hotel. Students need to have a substantial breakfast before we leave and bring a packed lunch &snacks.

Specific clothing and safety items are required for this activity. The following can be purchased at an additional cost:

- Ski jackets AND pants can be hired for an additional fee of \$48 pp
- Jackets only can be hired for \$36 pp
- Pants only can be <u>hired</u> for \$36 pp
- Gloves can be bought for \$25 pp
- Goggles can be bought for \$40 pp

Once places are finalised, you will receive further information about how to order the above.

PLEASE NOTE:

Due to the nature of this excursion, we are limited to **50 SPOTS ONLY**. This will be managed by a **'first in best dressed'** process via Sentral:

- On Tuesday 14 May the event will go live on Sentral at 09am. Parents will then be able to log on, give your child permission, and pay a \$100 deposit to secure their spot.
- After the 50 spots have been filled by permission & payment, Sentral will continue to allow you to apply and will use that information to automatically generate a waiting list for those who fell outside of the first 50 (based on timestamp of response).
- If your child is not offered a spot but you paid a deposit, the office can arrange to redirect it to another upcoming expense (e.g. Excursions, Camp, JP Racing, Graduation). For alternative arrangements, please contact Karra McLeod in the office.
- If your child is on the waiting list, you will be contacted by Jess Powrie if a spot becomes available.

We are interested in engaging parents to help supervise students on the mountain throughout the day. **To be considered as a parent helper**, you must complete the Google form sent in the email from Jess Powrie or via this link: https://forms.gle/ujxJQoxDRNfc1vL16. Applications for parent helpers are required by **Wednesday 15th May** in order to finalise arrangements.

The form will ask you to outline information about your current Working with Children Check and your level of experience skiing/snowboarding. Without this, you will not be considered. Please note that in order to be considered, <u>a level of skiing/boarding will be required.</u> Thanks for your understanding.

By providing permission for this event, you are agreeing to all details outlined in this letter.
