To support the Level 6 Inquiry topic on Australian History we have organised an excursion to the MCG and Australian Sports Museum where we will explore how the iconic landmark and sport help shape our national identity. The students will be taken on a guided tour of the stadium, exploring the inner sanctum of the ground and learning about the heritage and significance of the MCG. Expert guides will share tales of the history of the venue, the sporting greats who have competed here and behind-the-scenes insights into match and event days. Students will then be given time to explore The Australian Museum of Sport, which encourages activity, experimentation, competition and collaboration. Finally, students will be lucky enough to meet an Australian Olympian and hear about their journey to national success.
